Certificate of Proficiency

The certificate program in criminal justice includes primarily courses specific to the field with a limited number of general education courses. To enroll in the program, the student must meet the regular college entrance requirements. The certificate represents recognition of the achievement of the criminal justice curriculum for the professional who does not plan to enter a degree program, or it may be considered an important milestone for the in-service student working towards a degree.
