Testing and Placement Prior to admission to the Dept. of Special Education and Teacher of Students with Disabilities, the following criteria must be met:

- A cumulative grade-point average of 2.75 or better;
- A speech-and-language screening test (call 908-737-5357 for an appointment);
- A minimum grade of B- in ENG 151 (or equivalent);
- A minimum grade of B- in MATH 151 (or equivalent);
- A minimum grade of B- in EDUC 178 (or equivalent);
- A minimum grade of B- in COMM 154 (or equivalent);
- Satisfactory completion (with grade of B- or better) of SPED 2120 (Introductory Field Experience), or in the case of transfer students, an equivalent experience; and SPED 2200;
- A minimum of 60 credits;
- Praxis I must be passed with the necessary Department of Education scores.

Exit Requirements:

- A cumulative grade-point average of 2.75 or better;
- Satisfactory completion of all courses requirements.
