WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

Students and parents (if student is unmarried and under 24 years of age) must bring complete copies of their 2009 Federal Tax Returns (including schedules) and W-2s. This information is required in order to answer income questions on either the FAFSA or FAFSA4caster worksheets. If this information is not available by the date of your scheduled workshop, please contact the Ocean County College Financial Aid office at (732) 255-0310 to receive guidance on alternative documentation that can be used to estimate information.
