POLICY

Effective the first day of classes in September 2005, smoking is permitted on-campus only in the parking lots.

Smoking is also prohibited in all college vehicles.

PROCEDURE

1. Implementation:

- a. Signs shall be posted at the entrance to college buildings indicating:

SMOKING IS PROHIBITED

- b. Signs shall be posted in strategic locations throughout the campus indicating:

Smoking is permitted only in parking lots.

2. Supervision

The Security personnel shall be responsible for monitoring all smoking violations and submission of a written report of violations to the supervisor of the area concerned, with a copy to the area Vice President. If the Vice President deems it appropriate, he/she will report the matter to the President. In all cases involving students, a copy of the report will be submitted to the Dean of Special Services.

3. Enforcement/Compliance:

- a. Any person who smokes in college buildings or on college grounds other than parking lots in violation of this regulation is subject to the provisions of applicable laws, rules and regulations and/or college disciplinary action.
- b. Ensuring compliance with the policy regarding permissible areas of smoking is the responsibility of the entire college community.
