

POLICY

All students who wish to enroll in MATH 191 or higher must meet one of the following criteria:

1. earn a passing grade in the prerequisite course(s), OR
2. attain the appropriate placement score on the College Level Mathematics Test

ADOPTED: May 4, 2004

PROCEDURE

Currently enrolled students who earn a passing grade in course prerequisites may advance accordingly.

Incoming students who wish to enroll in MATH 191 or higher must take the College Level Mathematics Test. Placement in these courses is based on the following chart.

* Use student's declared major and high school grades in Algebra II, Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus and/or Calculus for final determination of placement.

- A grade block and a College Level Mathematics score block will be instituted by OIT to ensure appropriate course placement
- Any student who wishes to appeal his/her placement must petition the Dean of the Mathematics Department (or his/her designee) for resolution.
