

POLICY

GENERAL

1. A bona fide resident of Ocean County is defined as a person who has established legal domicile in the county prior to the date of enrollment and has been legally domiciled in the state for a least one year or if a dependent minor, resides with parents or legal guardians who meet this definition.
2. Members of the military services on extended active duty, and their dependents, who are assigned to any United States military installation qualify for residency.
3. Students in residence at other accredited colleges in Ocean County are considered Ocean County residents.

QUALIFICATIONS

Students covered by paragraphs 2 and 3 above must meet the same standards and complete the same admissions as required of all Ocean County residents.

TUITION

Students covered by paragraphs 2 and 3 above will be charged the same tuition and fee rate established for Ocean County residents.

ENROLLMENT

The number of students to be enrolled will be based upon available facilities, and will be established by the Board of Trustees upon recommendation of the President.

VETERANS

Veterans of the Armed Forces who meet admission requirements will be given enrollment preference.
