

POLICY

Ocean County residents at least 55 years of age may activate a yearly membership in the Academy and subsequently enroll in any college credit course at a reduced rate tuition. A tuition and fee schedule for credit courses and a yearly membership fee for the Academy shall be established by the Board of Trustees. Active members of the Academy will be eligible to attend college cultural events at a reduced rate and other Academy-sponsored activities for free or reduced rates.

Academy for Lifelong Learning Members

Annual membership fee (July 1 - June 30).\$30.00

ADOPTED: November 5, 2001

PROCEDURE

1. All applicants to the Academy shall complete an annual membership application and pay the annual membership fee.
2. All Academy members interested in taking college credit courses shall complete an application for admission and submit it to the Admission and Records Office.
3. A reduced tuition rate schedule will be included on the list of charges as approved by the Board of Trustees.
4. Academy students must purchase their own textbooks.
5. The Ocean County College Office of Continuing and Professional Education will certify 55 years of age or over and county residency, and issue an annual OCC Academy for Lifelong Learning card.
6. Academy students will be required to present their membership card for the purpose of having their tuition charge reduced. Eligible students shall pay laboratory fees, technology fees, registration, and parking fees. Normal fine or penalty fees such as library, parking and bad check will apply.
7. Academy students may register for credit courses during all approved registration periods.
