

POLICY

Ocean County high school juniors or seniors may enroll in any college credit course at a reduced rate tuition. Reduced tuition rate applies to courses taken by the student between the summer immediately preceding the junior year in high school and the spring semester of the senior year in high school. A tuition and fee schedule shall be established by the Board of Trustees.

PROCEDURE

1. All applicants to Ocean County College who are currently enrolled as juniors or seniors in Ocean County high schools are eligible for reduced tuition and fees between the summer immediately preceding the fall semester of the high school junior year and the spring semester of the high school senior year.
2. All high school students interested in taking college credit courses shall comply with policy 5122 (general requirements for admission), complete an application for admission and submit it to the Admission and Records Office.
3. Upon acceptance into the college, high school students may register for credit courses during all approved registration periods.
4. A reduced tuition rate schedule will be included on the list of charges as approved by the Board of Trustees.
5. High school students must purchase their own textbooks.
6. The Ocean County College Office of Admission and Records will certify the applicants as currently enrolled high school juniors or seniors for tuition paying purposes. Eligible students shall pay laboratory fees, technology fees, registration, and parking fees. Normal fine or penalty fees such as library, parking and bad check will apply.
