- Adopted a resolution to award contract for the purchase of a new telephone system
- Adopted a resolution to award a contract for professional information technology management services from Collegis, Inc. at OCC from January 1, 2004, through December 31, 2008
- Adopted a resolution to enter into an agreement, with a \$100,000 participation contribution, to become a member of the New Jersey Community College Consortium for Workforce and Economic Development, organized under the auspices of the New Jersey Council of County Colleges, to maximize New Jersey community college sale and delivery of Department of Labor and client-funded customized training programs
- Accepted the following grant awards:
 - ▶ \$506,685 from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to support the Barnegat Bay National Estuary Program in the implementation of its Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan, with \$528,185 available in the matching funds, for a total of \$1,034,870. Funding period: October 1, 2003, through September 30, 2005. Project director: Dr. Robert Scro, Director of the Barnegat Bay National Estuary Program
 - ▶ \$458,252 from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, under its New Jersey Health Initiatives Program, for three-year support of a program to increase the supply of registered nurses in acute hospital settings. Project period: October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2006. Project Director: Dr. James Brown, Dean of Health Sciences and Human Performance.
 - ▶ \$15,000 from the New Jersey Higher Education Consortium, funded by the Department of Health and Senior Services, Division of Addiction Services, to support the continuation of a party drug prevention resource site at OCC. Grant period: July 1, 2003, through June 30, 2004. Project Director: Sandy Carine; Project Coordinator: Kate Pandolpho
 - ▶ \$250,000 from the U.S. Department of Energy/National Energy Technology Laboratory, for the installation and operation of an energy fuel cell campus. Funding period: September 30, 2003, through September 15, 2006. Projected Director: Kenneth Olsen
