OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE OFFERS SUMMER CAMPS FOR KIDS

TOMS RIVER – Fun-filled adventures await! The Department of Continuing and Professional Education at Ocean County College is offering more than 90 **summer programs for kids of all ages**. Over 20 new camps have been added this year!

Plan to register your children early, as class size is limited.

The “Kids on Campus” programs are intended to be an educational and fun summer experience for children, who can choose from a variety of subjects, including: animals, art, building and engineering, computers, dance/film/theatre, digital arts, language, math, mind-building, sailing, science, and sports.

Children can explore nature; develop hidden creativity; improve reading, writing, or math skills; and experience good old-fashioned summertime fun!

Also, new this summer, OCC has added a lunch care program and aftercare camps. The supervised lunch program allows students to stay on campus between their morning and afternoon camps, if they so wish. Students can bring their own lunch or purchase it at the cafeteria on campus. Campers will then be escorted to their afternoon classes. Only morning camps that end at noon are available for this program.

The aftercare camp is offered from 4:00 to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday as a service to working parents. Students will be escorted from their afternoon camp to the aftercare program, where supervised activities will be offered in a relaxed atmosphere. Only camps that run to 4:00 p.m. are eligible.
