PREPARE TO BECOME A SUBSTITUTE SCHOOL NURSE/TEACHER AT OCC

TOMS RIVER – Are you a licensed New Jersey Registered Nurse interested in becoming a substitute school nurse? The Office of School Relations at Ocean County College is offering a training seminar to prepare nurses to become substitute school nurses or to serve as a refresher in-service program. A one-day **Substitute School Nurse Training Institute** will be held on **Saturday, March 13**, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., in Room 105, Nursing Building, OCC's Main Campus, College Drive, Toms River, NJ.

Licensed New Jersey RN's will learn how to: employ successful nursing techniques, procedures and skills; gain and sustain appropriate rapport with students; and clearly articulate doctors' orders and procedures. Participants will update their clinical skills.

To qualify to become a substitute school nurse, a candidate must be a New Jersey licensed Registered Nurse, provide a copy of his or her current valid RN license, have at least 60 college credits, provide an official transcript in a sealed envelope, successfully undergo a criminal background check, and provide proof of a negative Mantoux (TB) test.

Cost: \$90 (includes tuition/fees: \$50, lab fees: \$26, materials: \$14).
