## SSAOCC SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

Four monetary awards will be given totaling \$2,000. This amount will be distributed evenly among the four categories. In the event of a tie, funds will be divided evenly to each successful grantee within the category.

I. **Eligibility:**

A graduating student who is a spouse of dependent (claimed on latest IRs tax return) of a Support Staff employee.

**Threshold Criteria:**

A grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher\*

**Defining Criteria:**

Extracurricular volunteer work on campus or community service or full-time or part-time work.

II. **Eligibility:**

A part-time student, currently enrolled, who has attended for four consecutive semesters and **who will be attending in the Fall 2015 semester.**

**Threshold Criteria:**

A grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher\*

**Defining Criteria:**

Must be enrolled in a degree program and employed part-time or full-time. Highest GPA.

III. **Eligibility:**

A full-time student currently enrolled in a specific major and who will be attending in the the Fall 2015 semester. **For 2015 the chosen major is: LIBERAL ARTS**

**Threshold Criteria:**

A grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher\*

**Defining Criteria:**

Student must be employed part-time or full-time. Highest GPA.

IV. **Eligibility:**

Graduating student worker in the College Work Study Program.

**Threshold Criteria:**

Highest grade point average (GPA).\*

**NOTE: Proof of eligibility and criteria must be presented along with application. Failure to do so will result in automatic elimination.**

**The screening/selection committee will be composed of two members of the SSAOCC plus the chairperson of the scholarship committee.**

**Scholarship award notification will be made in May by the Supportive Staff Association. Awards I and IV will be given in May 2015; II and III will be distributed to returning students in October 2015.**

All awards will be issued to the individual grantee.
