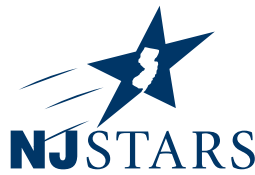

The Admissions Office is located in the Jon & Judith Larson Student Center (building #8), on the second floor. 1 Complete the Federal financial aid paperwork	To apply for federal student aid, visit www.FAFSA.ed.gov . OCC's school code is 002624 and must be placed as the first choice. 2 Submit your transcripts	All NJ Stars students must submit a copy of their official High School and any post-secondary school transcripts to our Registration & Records Office. For assistance call 732.255.0304.	Submit transcripts after the online application is complete	<input type="checkbox"/>
3 Submit your college placement test scores, AP scores, and any college credits completed	Submit your official test scores to the Office of Registration & Records: Critical Reading 540; Math 530 If you do not have these scores, schedule an appointment to take the Accuplacer Test at OCC visiting go.ocean.edu/test . 4 Complete your State financial aid paperwork*	Apply for NJ STARS awards and complete the additional information for the upcoming academic year. It is the responsibility of each student to apply to HESAA for your NJ STARS award and place Ocean County College as your first choice. 5 Register for Selective Service*	All males aged 18-25 are required to register with the Selective Service System. Apply by visiting FAFSA.ed.gov or SSS.gov .	Should accompany FAFSA	<input type="checkbox"/>
6 Financial verification by Federal and/or State*	If selected for verification, submit all the requested paperwork (usually this includes worksheets, tax returns, etc.) to the Financial Aid Office. 7 Schedule orientation and register for classes	Visit http://go.ocean.edu/SignUp and log in to your Ocean Connect account. You are now ready to select and register for your Orientation.	Open enrollment	<input type="checkbox"/>
8 Check your email	Visit Ocean Connect to access your email. Your OCC email is important. You will receive official college information as well as NJ STARS updates via your OCC email account.	Open enrollment	<input type="checkbox"/>
9 Pay the fees portion of your semester bill	Visit Ocean Connect to access Student Finance and receive your current bill. If you have questions or concerns regarding your bill, contact the Student Billing Office at 732.255.0324.	Once the NJ STARS award is posted on your account, you will be responsible for paying the remainder of the bill within 24 hours.	<input type="checkbox"/>
10 Familiarize yourself with classroom materials	NOTE: Students receiving financial aid can begin purchasing their books from the OCC Bookstore on the first day of their classes. Books can also be purchased online through the OCC Bookstore website with your financial aid (if your aid exceeds your tuition cost) prior to class and picked up on the first day of class.
