Find Books - Use the [OCCcat](#) to locate books in the library on your topic:

- Perform a **word or phrase search** using terms such as "*MLA Handbook*" or combine terms like "*writing and style*." Word or phrase searches look through the entire catalog record, so combining terms like this may help narrow a search and give better results.
- Perform a **subject search** using terms such as "*style manual*" to search for items on a specific topic.
