Mr. Lomell is a highly decorated former United States Army Ranger who served in World War II and is known for his actions in the first hours of **D-Day** at **Pointe du Hoc** on the coast of **Normandy**, France, and for his bravery in the Battle of Hurtgen Forest.

For his heroic actions during World War II, Mr. Lomell received the U.S. Army's Distinguished Service Cross, the Bronze Star, the British Military Medal, the French Legion d'Honneur, and the Silver Star.

I hope you will join us on September 12th for a wonderful evening. The proceeds of the Gala will assist deserving students in continuing their education through Ocean County College Foundation scholarships.

Financial Aid

Financial aid statistics have been compiled for FY 2009, and they are impressive. The number of students served grew from 9,217 in FY 2008 to 11,889 in FY 2009, a 29 percent increase. Aid distributed also increased 29 percent from \$16.6 million in FY 2008 to \$21 million in FY 2009.

Dr. Norma Betz, Director of Financial Aid, and Mr. Don Doran, Vice President of Student Affairs, will share with you at the September Board meeting the ways in which financial aid is driving enrollment and supporting a large portion of our student population.
