**Monday Meeting at the Marine Academy for Technology and Environmental Sciences (MATES) Facility**

**Dr. William Hoey, Superintendent of the Ocean County Vocational-Technical School, will join us on Monday** when we meet at the **Marine Academy for Technology and Environmental Sciences (MATES) facility** at the **Southern Education Center**. Mr. Hoey will **say a few words** about the new center and the **collaboration** between **OCC** and the **Vo-Tech School**. A **tour** of the building will be offered for the trustees after the meeting.

**Senior Assistant to the President/Ombudsman**

For several months, **negotiations** have been ongoing regarding the **acquisition of land** surrounding the college. **Mr. Dave Wolfe, Senior Assistant to the President/Ombudsman**, has been working closely with the **property owners** and the **County Freeholders** on this project. On Monday, Mr. Wolfe will provide you with an **update** on this and other **expansion plans** and will also discuss his efforts to **strengthen college/corporate relationships**.

## **Enrollment Highlights**

### ◆ **Fall 2006**

OCC has set a **record** with the **highest number** of students enrolled and **total credit hours** for fall 2006. The total fall **headcount** is **8,889**, representing an **increase** of **4.1%** over the last fall semester. The **total credits** are **87,701**, a **7.1% increase** over last fall semester.

**Ethnicity** – A total of **1,137 minority students** enrolled this fall, representing **12.9%** of the students and a **2.5% increase** over last fall. The total number of **Hispanic** students, **554**, also sets a **record** with a **7.2% increase** over last fall, while **Asian** students **increased 1.5%** and **African-American** students **decreased 5.0%** from the last fall semester.

**Gender** – About **40%** of the students are **male** and **60%** are **female**. This proportion has remained relatively **the same** over the **last decade**.

**Age** – With the increasing number of full-time students, the **overall average age** has been **declining** over the last decade from **26.2 to 23.8**. For the fall 2006 semester, the **average age** for **female** students is **24.9** and for **male** students is **22.0**. The **youngest** student is **15 years**, and the **oldest** is **81**.

### ◆ **FY 2007**

It is **expected** that the **growth** in **enrollment** and **credits hours** for FY 2006-2007 **will continue** as a result of these increases in the fall semester. Other **contributing factors** include:

- ◆ The **NJ STARS Program**
- ◆ The **Kean-Ocean partnership**
- ◆ The College's **proactive enrollment management**

### ◆ **Summer 2006**

Compared with summer 2005, the **total headcount** is **up 3.0% (4,176)** for 2006 summer terms, and the total number of **credits** is **up 1.0%**.

## **Financial Aid**

As a result of assistance from an outside consulting firm, **Financial Aid Services**, and the subsequent **restructuring** of our **Financial Aid Office**, there has been a **dramatic increase** in the number of student **financial aid awards** and a **significant improvement** in the **overall quality of service** to financial aid students.

At Monday's meeting, **Ms. Sara Winchester, Vice President of Finance**, will introduce **Ms. Norma Betz**, formerly with Financial Aid Services, who is now joining the OCC staff as **Director of Financial Aid**. She will share with the trustees the **advances** that have been made **in the office** over the past two years and briefly describe **future plans** for the operation of the office.

### The Ocean County College Foundation

The **Ocean County College Foundation Gala**, which was held on **Saturday, September 9<sup>th</sup>**, was very **successful**. Almost **400 attendees** enjoyed a wonderful evening with a '50's theme. The Gala raised over **\$275,000** for the Foundation's **general scholarship fund**.

The OCC Foundation continues to be committed to meeting the **educational needs** of **Ocean County residents** through **scholarships, endowments, and capital and special projects**.

### Disability Awareness Month

The month of **October** is designated **nationally** as **Disability Awareness Month** in recognition of individuals with disabilities. OCC's very successful **Disability Services Program**, which is **one of seven regional centers** in the **state**, provides outstanding **professional resources** and **learning accommodations** to **students with disabilities**. **Ms. Maureen Reustle, Dean of the Center for Academic Services**, will give you a **report** on Monday regarding the **programs and special events** developed for Disability Awareness Month.

I **respectfully request** that the trustees **adopt** the attached **resolution** at Monday's meeting to proclaim **October 2006** as **Disability Awareness Month at OCC** and to **encourage participation** by members of the college in all related **activities** to **raise consciousness** regarding the **accomplishments** of individuals with disabilities.

A **Webcast Executive Briefing** is being offered on **Monday, October 30<sup>th</sup>**, by **Timecruiser**, the company that provides our **CampusCruiser** portal, the **communications infrastructure** within the college community. **Ocean County College** is being featured in this Briefing, with **Mr. Chip Stoll, Chief Information Officer**, and **Dr. Kathy Tietge, Assistant Professor of Philosophy and History** and current **Chair** of the **College Senate**, presenting a seminar on “**Effective Portal Collaboration Starts with Leadership Commitment.**” This presentation focuses on OCC’s **executive commitment** to the **improvement of communication processes** that paved the way for **successful collaboration**. Highlighted in this presentation will be the success of OCC’s “**Governance**” **content area**, which can be utilized by the entire college community.
