

POLICY

Smoking is not permitted on-campus or at any location that can reasonably be regarded as an extension of the campus. This smoking prohibition extends to smokeless tobacco and electronic vapor emitting devices, as well as the smoking of any other substance.

Smoking is also prohibited in all college vehicles.

PROCEDURE

1. Implementation:

- a. Signs shall be posted at the entrance to college buildings indicating:

SMOKING IS PROHIBITED ON CAMPUS.

- b. Signs shall be posted in strategic locations throughout the campus indicating:

Smoking is prohibited on campus.

2. Supervision

The Security personnel shall be responsible for monitoring all smoking violations and submission of a written report of violations to the supervisor of the area concerned, with a copy to the area Vice President. If the Vice President deems it appropriate, he/she will report the matter to the President. In all cases involving students, a copy of the report will be submitted to the Vice President of Student Affairs.

3. Enforcement/Compliance:

- a. Any person who smokes in college buildings or on college grounds other than parking lots in violation of this regulation is subject to the provisions of applicable laws, rules and regulations and/or college disciplinary action.
- b. Ensuring compliance with the nonsmoking policy is the responsibility of the entire college community.
