BYLAWS FOR THE OPERATION  
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
Qualifications of members,  
terms of office, filling  
vacancies, compensation #1215

### BYLAW

Appointed members of the Board of Trustees shall have been residents of Ocean County for a period of four years prior to said appointments, and no elected public official or employee of the county college shall serve as a voting member of the board. The term of office of appointed members, except for the first appointments, shall be for four years. Each member shall serve until his/her successor shall have been appointed.

Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment for the remainder of the unexpired term. Any appointed member may be removed by the Ocean County Board of Chosen Freeholders for cause upon notice and opportunity to be heard. Members shall serve without compensation but shall be entitled to be reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses.

A voting member of the Board of Trustees shall not be eligible to accept employment as an employee of the college for a period of two years following resignation or expiration of his/her term as a member.

Members initially appointed to the Board may serve from the time of their respective appointments, but the term of such office shall be deemed to commence as of November 1 of the year in which the appointment was made.
