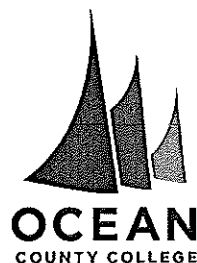

This course introduces students to traditional ethical theories *from a multicultural perspective and to the nature of ethical thinking. It also* and considers some of the major unresolved ethical issues of our time. Possible contemporary ethical issues covered include socially sanctioned taking of human life; sexual behavior and its broader social implications; equality; discrimination and reverse discrimination; violence; social, environmental and political effects of globalization; economic justice and welfare; pornography and censorship; the values of a business society; and alienation in the modern world; *bioethics of cloning, genetic engineering, stem cell research; and / or contemporary issues of concern drawn from today's headline news.*
