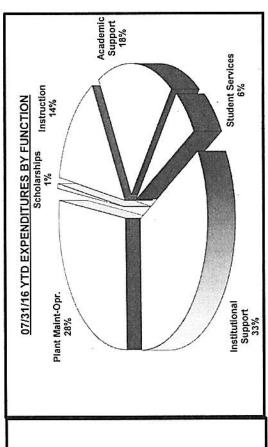

  - b. For the purchase of miscellaneous electrical supplies for use at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-10)
  - c. For the purchase of an automated applicant tracking management system for use by the Human Resources Department at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-11)
  - d. For the first year of a three-year agreement for the Adobe Enterprise software license for use at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-12)
  - e. For the authorization of the purchase of natural gas supply services for use at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-13)
- 4. Recommend that the following contracts be amended:

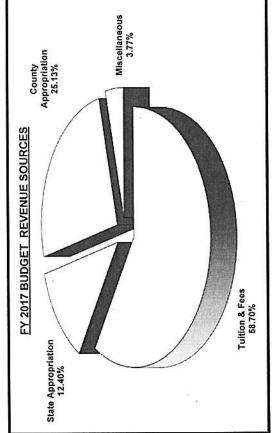
