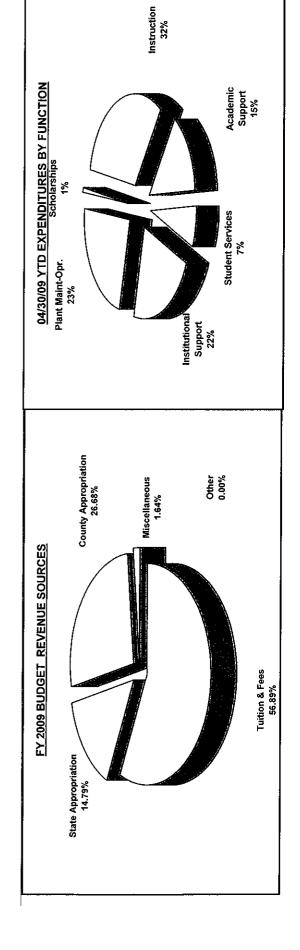

- 5. Recommend adoption of a resolution authorizing the submission of an application for a \$369,719 award from the New Jersey Department of Education for the continuation of a grant through the Carl D. Perkins Vocational and Technical Education Act to support instructional equipment and supplies, professional development, student travel, and tutoring. The emphasis for this funding cycle will be on Career Clusters that support workforce development, economic development, and stakeholder partnerships. Funding period: July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010. Project director: Ms. Gina Suriano, Director of Grants.
