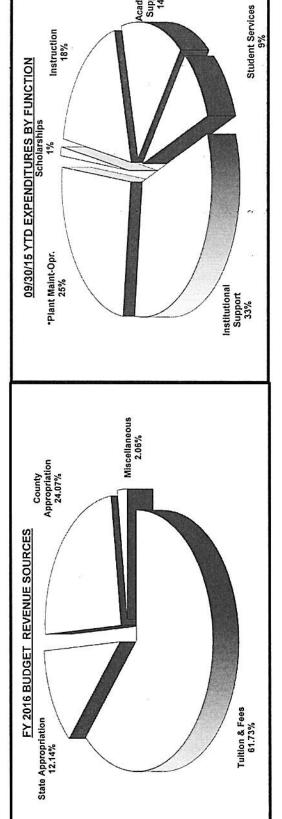

- g. An additional \$10,707.93, for a maximum total of \$71,889.93, to G.M.H. Associates of America, Inc., Trenton, New Jersey, for expedited delivery pricing for replacement of sewage ejection pumps at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the October 16, 2015, Board retreat) (Exhibit A-18)

Recommend the rescission of the \$14,500 contract awarded to Recycle Solutions Corporation, Paterson, New Jersey, for chain link fencing as Recycle Solutions Corporation failed to meet the specifications and requirements of the original proposal, and recommend that the contract be awarded to the next lowest bidder, Majestic Fence Company, Howell, New Jersey, at \$17,120 for the purchase and installation of chain link fencing (contract originally awarded at the October 5, 2015, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-19)

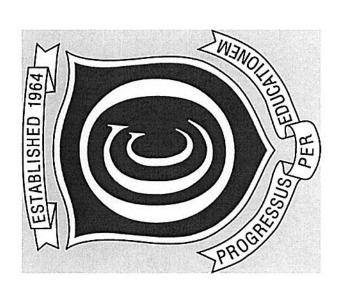
