



### RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College (the "College" or "OCC") wishes to partner with Ben Hudnall Memorial Trust (the Trust), a non-profit, unincorporated trust, associated with Kaiser Permanente, an integrated managed care consortium based in Oakland, California; and
- WHEREAS, OCC and the Trust wish to enter into a partnership for the period of December 9, 2016, through December 31, 2019, with the intention of establishing a long-term relationship; and
- WHEREAS, the College will provide the following seven e-learning courses at pre-negotiated rates to registered Kaiser Permanente employees who are determined to be eligible Trust participants at the time of their registration to the course(s):
  - Principles of Biology (BIOL 114)
  - Preparatory Chemistry (CHEM 180)
  - Human Anatomy and Physiology I (BIOL 130)
  - Human Anatomy and Physiology II (BIOL 131)
  - Microbiology (BIOL 232)
  - Organic Chemistry I (CHEM 283)
  - Organic Chemistry II (CHEM 284)
- WHEREAS, Kaiser Permanente employees will be placed in regularly scheduled sections of the above courses using master courses already in use at OCC, and OCC may revise or update the courses per OCC procedures for use in this program; and
- WHEREAS, certain other costs, such as the actual cost of textbooks and any applicable taxes, will be billed to the Trust by the College; and
- WHEREAS, the specific terms of this arrangement will be incorporated into an agreement to be executed by OCC and the Trust;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ocean County College Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the President to execute an agreement with the Ben Hudnall Memorial Trust in substantially the same form as incorporated herein by reference.

### Contract for Maintenance Service on the Combined Heat and Power (CHP) Plant Generator/Engine and Materials and Supplies

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College recognizes the need to amend the \$51,384.00 contract awarded by Resolution on June 28, 2016 to Waukesha-Pierce Industries, 203 Freedom Drive, Lawrence, PA. 15055; and

WHEREAS, the original contract for service for the CHP plant, required by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities for the maintenance of the Waukesha APG1000 engine/generator, shall be amended for the purchase of additional materials and supplies in the amount of \$6,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the goods and services are exempt from bidding pursuant to the provision of N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.5 et seq. and is sole source; and

WHEREAS, Waukesha-Pierce Industries is the only company available to service the combined heat and power plant Waukesha-Pierce engine/generator; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Vice President of Finance and Administration of Ocean County College has determined and certified in writing that the total value of the acquisition will exceed: \$17,500.00; and

WHEREAS, a Certificate has been provided by the Executive Vice President of Finance and Administration of Ocean County College, stating that funds are available for this purpose, which certificate is attached to the original of this resolution and is on file in the office of the Executive Vice President of Finance and Administration; and

WHEREAS, the vendor has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the County of Ocean the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit making any reportable contributions through the term on the contract; and

WHEREAS, Ocean County College wishes to award said contract without the need for public bidding in compliance with the provisions of the County College Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.1 et seq., and the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et, seq.;

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES as follows:
