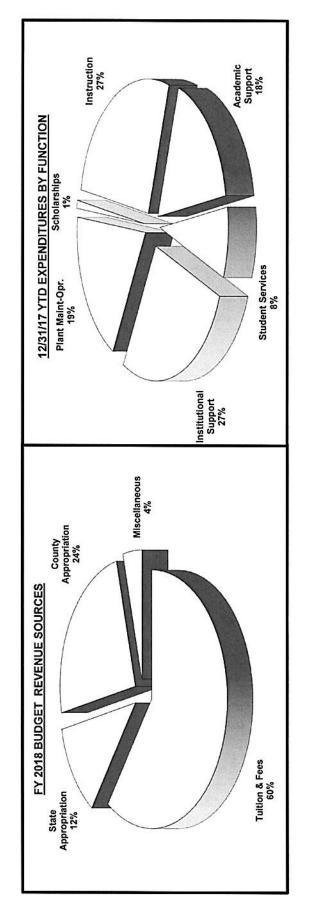
Prior to taking action on the revision to Policy #5300, Tuition and Fees, in accordance with New Jersey Public Law 94, Chapter 48, the Board of Trustees will conduct a public hearing for those members of the College community who wish to testify.

- 2. Recommend revision of Policy #5300, Students, Tuition and Fees (Exhibit A-2)
- 3. Recommend approval of the Ocean County College FY 2019 budget (Exhibit A-3)
- 4. Recommend that the following contracts be awarded:
  - a. For professional construction services for the Hub renovation project in the Administration Building at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-4)
  - b. For the purchase, installation, and configuration of an upgrade to the Electronic Access Control System for use by the Security Department at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-5)

  - d. For professional engineering services for a redesign and construction administration and management of the hot and chilled water loop extension from the Central Plant to select buildings on campus at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-7)

## **POLICY**

## Public Hearing

Prior to adoption of the college's tuition/fee schedule the Board of Trustees shall conduct a public hearing so that an opportunity to be heard will be afforded those members of the college community who wish to address the proposed tuition/fee revisions. The public hearing may be scheduled to occur during a previously scheduled public meeting of the Board of Trustees. Not less than seven days in advance of the public hearing the Secretary of the Board shall provide notice of the hearing by posting announcements on the College's website, by publicizing in the OCC Viking News (when possible), and/or by posting announcement via broadcast e-mail to College employees.

## 2. Schedule of Tuition and Fees

The tuition and fee rates for credit courses applicable to all students are set forth on the attached schedule effective as of the date indicated. In order to recover costs not paid for by appropriations from Ocean County, out-of-county students not enrolled under chargeback certification are required to pay higher tuition charges; out-of-state students pay even higher tuition charges in order to recover costs not paid for by appropriations from Ocean County and the State of New Jersey.

## College/Student Fee

This fee is established as a per credit charge and partially covers expenses that include student government, student clubs and organizations, student publications, student social activities, student health services, counseling services, transfer and placement services, financial aid services, admissions and records services, and intercollegiate athletics. Out-of-county, out-of-state, and out-of-country students pay the same college/student fee as county residents. Out-of-County e-Learning students are excluded.

## 4. Course Fees

A course fee as listed on the attached schedule will be required of all students enrolled in certain designated courses. Fee categories appear in the college catalog at the conclusion of the applicable course descriptions.

## 5. Ocean County Senior Citizen Tuition Rate

Eligible Ocean County senior residents (see Policy #5325 for eligibility criteria) may enroll in college credit courses on a space available basis at a reduced rate tuition as shown on the attached schedule. Senior residents shall pay course fees, and other required fees as provided in the approved schedule of tuition and fees, except for the college/student fee, and excluding all online courses.

## 6. National Guard Tuition Waiver

Eligible NJ National Guard and their surviving spouses and children (see Policy #5335 for eligibility criteria) will be permitted to enroll in any college credit course (not to exceed 15 credits per semester) without payment of tuition charges. However, students enrolled under this waiver will be required to pay all college/student fees, course fees, late fees and other fees listed on the schedule of tuition and fees.

## 7. Tuition Waiver for Eligible Participants in Job Training Programs

Eligible New Jersey Job Training Program Participants (see Policy #5340 for eligibility criteria) will be entitled to waiver of payment of that portion of tuition from the program which is not covered by financial aid. The program participant will be required to pay all other applicable fees.

## POLICY (Cont'd)

8. Volunteer Fire, First Aid and Rescue Squad Tuition Waiver

Eligible volunteer fire, first aid, and rescue squad volunteers, dependent children, and spouse (see Policy #5345 for eligibility criteria) will be permitted to enroll on a space available basis in any college credit course and receive up to \$600 in tuition credit per year, not to exceed \$2,400 for the member, children, and spouse collectively over a four-year period. Students enrolled under this waiver shall pay all college/student fees, course fees, late fees and other fees listed on the schedule of tuition and fees.

10. Eligible Ocean County High School Students

Eligible currently enrolled Ocean County high school students (see Policy #5122 for admission criteria and Policy #5327 for eligibility criteria) may enroll in college credit courses and receive a Board of Trustees scholarship award for twelve credits as shown on the attached schedule. Eligible high school students shall pay no college/student fees for twelve credits. This benefit excludes all online courses.

Re: Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Operating Budget Request

Enclosed is Ocean County College's Operating Budget Request for fiscal year July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019.

The overall budget is predicated on anticipated revenues in the amount of \$65,003,300. Compared to the operating budget for FY 2017-2018, the primary changes to our revenue sources are expected to be as follows:

Out-of-county e-Learning decrease (from \$225 per credit to \$137) \$3.00 in-county increase (from \$116 per credit to \$119) FY18 projected +2.0% FY18 actual No changes No changes State of New Jersey County of Ocean Student Fees Enrollment Tuition

On the expenditure side, overall expenses have increased by \$2.2 million. This increase is mainly the result of:

- Modest annual salary increases estimated at 2%
- Escalating insurance costs for employee health benefits (13% increase plan year 2018)
- Debt service contribution \$1.1m
- Software upgrades and maintenance
- Three new positions in Student Affairs, including AVP and Admissions support
  - Four new faculty/lecturer positions
- Additional IT, Facilities and Security staff to support opening of Instructional and Health Science Buildings

Subject to the OCC Board of Trustee's approval, this budget will next be presented to the Ocean County Board of School Estimate later in the year.

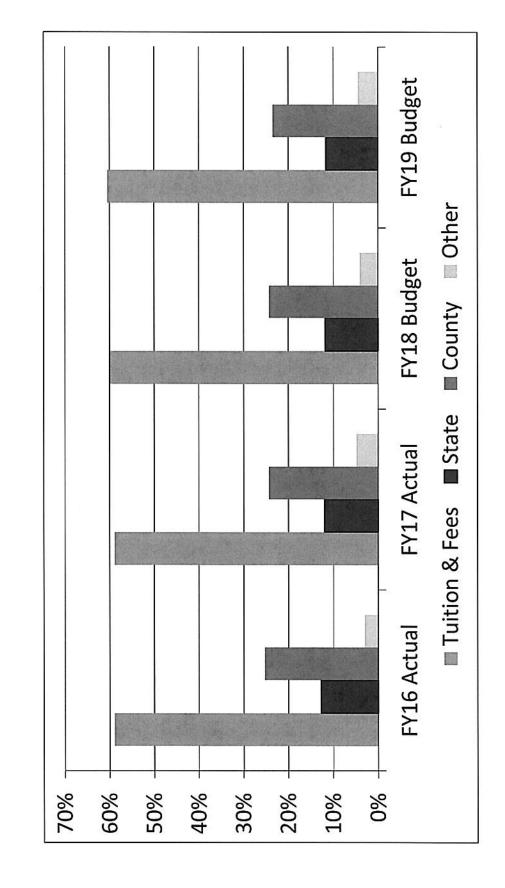

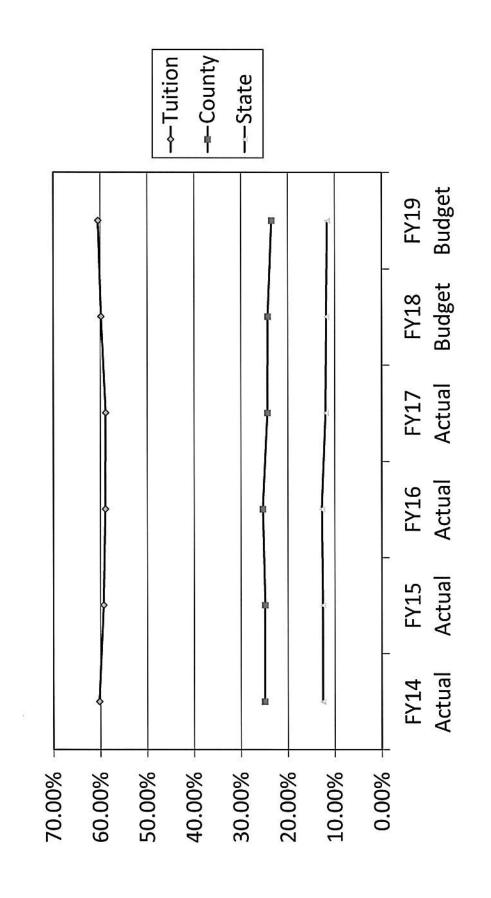

The County of Ocean Provides Additional Capital Support Not Reflected in the Operating Budget

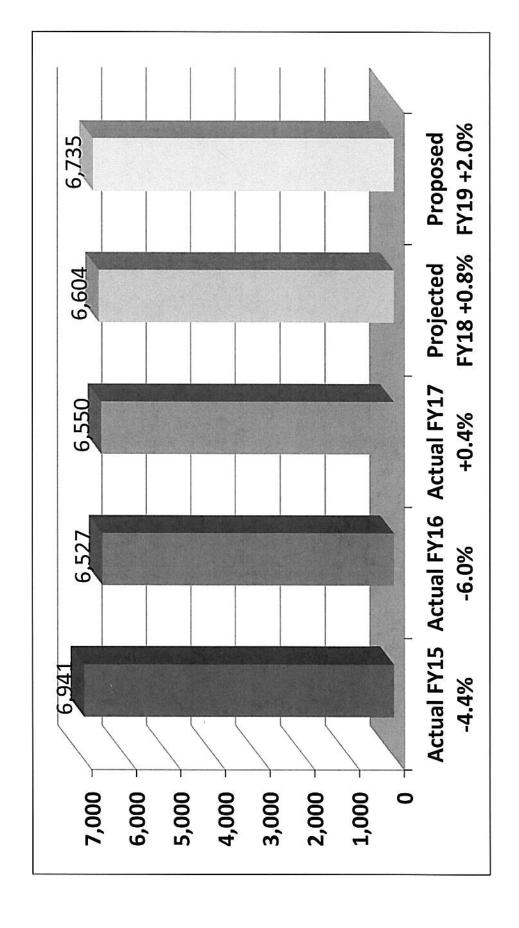
