This RFQ solicited proposals for architectural services, mechanical, electrical, plumbing and fire protection engineering services, civil engineering services, structural engineering services, landscaping design services, environmental engineering/consulting services, commissioning of HVAC systems and commissioning of information technology systems. It was determined, after the opening of proposals, that pricing solicited did not include all elements of cost. While all inclusive hourly rates were solicited, the actual number of hours required by a particular firm to complete a future project could not be ascertained. Accordingly, there is no assurance that the firm that bid the lowest all inclusive hourly rate will be the lowest bidder for a future project.
