Recommend adoption of a resolution authorizing the submission of an application for a \$70,170 grant award from the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Division on Women, to provide funding for services to meet the needs of displaced homemakers in Ocean County by fostering the development of career and employment skills and educational opportunities so clients and their families can become economically self-sufficient. Funding period: July 1, 2012, through June 30, 2013. Project director: Dr. Kate Pandolpho, Director of Career, Employment, and Counseling Services.

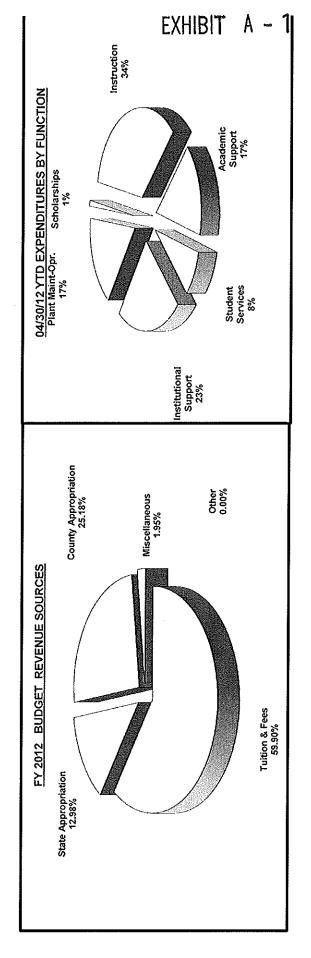
