The following Finance Committee items are recommended to the Ocean County College Board of Trustees for approval at its meeting on Monday, January 27, 2014:

- 1. Recommend acceptance of the statement of income and expenditures as of December 31, 2013 (Exhibit A-1)
- 2. Recommend adoption of a resolution to enter into and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the County of Ocean for the provision of parking lot and road improvements on certain lots and streets of the College, the amount not to exceed \$150,000, with up to \$115,000 to the Ocean County Engineering Department and up to \$35,000 to the Ocean County Road Department, effective through December 31, 2014. - e. An additional \$5,000, for a maximum total of \$847,294.65, to eCollege.com, DBA Pearson eCollege, Centennial, Colorado, for Pilot Program/Biometri Signature software as part of the development and promotion of Ocean County College's online programs (contract originally awarded at the May 29, 2012, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-21)
- f. An additional \$5,800, for a maximum total of \$22,270, to The DaVinci Group, LLC, Woodbury, New Jersey, for the identification of wet tap locations on the hot water distribution system as part of the engineering for the new campus pump at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the December 12, 2012, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-22)


- g. An additional \$15,400, for a maximum total of \$610,400, to Kimmel Bogrette Architecture + Site, Conshohocken, Pennsylvania, for engineering design to calculate heat load for new boilers and investigate and provide specifications for fuel cell removal as part of the architecture and engineering services for the Instructional Building renovations (contract originally awarded at the September 23, 2013, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-23)
- h. An additional \$40,000, for a maximum total of \$60,000, to Timothy Peters Plumbing and Heating Company, Inc., Manasquan, New Jersey, for additional plumbing services during the second year of a two-year agreement at the Ocean County College main campus and the Southern Education Center (contract originally awarded at the July 22, 2013, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-24)
- i. An additional \$122,644, for a maximum total of \$2,596,498, to Ellucian Company, LP, formerly SunGard Higher Education Managed Services, Inc., and Datatel, Inc., Chicago, Illinois, for a one-year agreement for instructional design support as part of the computer management services at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the July 23, 2012, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-25)
- j. An additional \$183,000, for a maximum total of \$1,038,349, to Concord Engineering Group, Inc., Voorhees, New Jersey, for a change order for additional engineering for added scope for heat exchangers and chiller to ensure reliable operation of the Combined Heat and Power Plant systems and to qualify for monetary incentives as part of the engineering services for the Combined Heat and Power Plant at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the September 21, 2009, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-26)
- 8. Recommend that the Board accept an \$8,500 grant award from the Ocean County Cultural and Heritage Commission to support performing arts activities at Ocean County College through a play performance based on Shakespearean work to commemorate the 450th birthday of Shakespeare. Project manager: Ms. Carol Kaunitz, Director of Auxiliary Services. Project period: January 1 through December 31, 2014.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, the County of Ocean has created and established a program to assist municipalities and governmental agencies in the repair and maintenance of municipal streets and property in addition to providing certain materials and supplies in connection therewith; and
- whereas, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College has requested the County to provide parking lot and road improvements on certain lots and streets of the College, not to exceed the sum of \$150,000, with up to \$115,000 to the Ocean County Engineering Department and up to \$35,000 to the Ocean County Road Department; and
- WHEREAS, Ocean County College wishes to enter into an agreement with the County of Ocean for the provision of these services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, as follows:

- 1. The President of Ocean County College is hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the County of Ocean.
- 2. This Agreement will be administered on behalf of Ocean County College by the President.
- This Agreement will provide parking lot and road improvements on certain lots and streets of Ocean County College by the County of Ocean, not to exceed the sum of \$150,000, with up to \$115,000 to the Ocean County Engineering Department and up to \$35,000 to the Ocean County Road Department.
- 4. A copy of this Agreement shall be kept on file and be available for public inspection in the Office of the President of Ocean County College.
- 5. This Agreement shall take effect upon full execution by the parties and shall remain in full force and effect through December 31, 2014. Sufficient funds have been appropriated and are available for this purpose in the current College budget.

OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE RESOLUTION

January 27, 2014

WHEREAS, an emergency condition existed on the Ocean County College main campus, Toms River, New Jersey;

WHEREAS, abnormally cold temperatures that began on January 3, 2014 caused several pipes to burst on the Ocean County College campus; this lead to a flood in the Administration Building which required immediate clean-up and mold prevention services and restoration. The building was closed for unimpeded clean-up and dry-out. Other pipe breaks on campus caused loss of heat in several buildings;

WHEREAS, the emergency began on January 3, 2014;

WHEREAS, it was necessary and imperative for the College to immediately address this problem to ensure for the health and safety of the occupants and public using the building;

WHEREAS, it was necessary to invoke N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.6 (emergency purchases and contracts) in order to obtain delivery of materials, supplies or the performance of the services required to mitigate the problem caused by the flood;

WHEREAS, contracts were awarded to DTZ for clean-up work, DKI for restoration work, Lowy's Moving Services, and Butler Office Interiors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, as follows:

 Purchase Order is issued to DTZ, 275 Grove St., Suite 3-200, Aubundale, MA 02466, in the amount of \$60,000.00.

Purchase Order is issued to DKI (Insurance Restoration Specialist), 30 Abeel Road, Monroe Township, NJ 08831, in the amount of \$135,000.00.

Purchase Order is issued to Lowy's Moving Service, PO Box 608, Neptune, NJ 07754, in the amount of \$7,000.00.

Purchase Order is issued to Butler Office Interiors, 1545 Route 37 W, Suite 3, Toms River, NJ 08755, in the amount of \$2,500.00.

Total amount of contracts is \$204,500.00

- WHEREAS, the New Jersey Council of County Colleges has requested the community college sector submit a request to release Chapter 12, Public Law 1971, Capital Facilities Projects, not to exceed \$2,300,000 for FY 2015; and the State of New Jersey Treasurer's Office is anticipated to release Chapter 12, P.L. 1971, WHEREAS, funds to the sector; and the State will commit these funds on a basis of fifty percent State and matching fifty WHEREAS, percent County formula; and the total project cost for the construction of a new Nursing/Information Technology WHEREAS, Building is estimated at \$16,450,000; and WHEREAS, the project will be funded by FY14 and FY15 Chapter 12. POLICY

1. Public Hearing

Prior to adoption of the college's tuition/fee schedule the Board of Trustees shall conduct a public hearing so that an opportunity to be heard will be afforded those members of the college community who wish to address the proposed tuition/fee revisions. The public hearing may be scheduled to occur during a previously scheduled public meeting of the Board of Trustees. Not less than seven days in advance of the public hearing the Secretary of the Board shall provide notice of the hearing by posting announcements on the College's website, by publicizing in the OCC Viking News (when possible), and/or by posting announcement via broadcast e-mail to College employees.

2. Schedule of Tuition and Fees

The tuition and fee rates for credit courses applicable to all students are set forth on the attached schedule effective as of the date indicated. In order to recover costs not paid for by appropriations from Ocean County, out-of-county students not enrolled under chargeback certification are required to pay higher tuition charges; out-of-state students pay even higher tuition charges in order to recover costs not paid for by appropriations from Ocean County and the State of New Jersey.

3. College/Student Fee

This fee is established as a per credit charge and partially covers expenses that include student government, student clubs and organizations, student publications, student social activities, student health services, counseling services, transfer and placement services, financial aid services, admissions and records services, and intercollegiate athletics. Out-of-county, out-of-state, and out-of-country students pay the same college/student fee as county residents. Out-of-County e-Learning students are excluded.

4. Course Fees

A course fee as listed on the attached schedule will be required of all students enrolled in certain designated courses. Fee categories appear in the college catalog at the conclusion of the applicable course descriptions.

5. Ocean County Senior Citizen Tuition Rate

Eligible Ocean County senior residents (see Policy #5325 for eligibility criteria) may enroll in college credit courses on a space available basis at a reduced rate tuition as shown on the attached schedule. Senior residents shall pay course fees, and other required fees as provided in the approved schedule of tuition and fees, except for the college/student fee, and excluding all online courses.

6. National Guard Tuition Waiver

Eligible NJ National Guard and their surviving spouses and children (see Policy #5335 for eligibility criteria) will be permitted to enroll in any college credit course (not to exceed 15 credits per semester) without payment of tuition charges. However, students enrolled under this waiver will be required to pay all college/student fees, course fees, late fees and other fees listed on the schedule of tuition and fees.

7. Tuition Waiver for Eligible Participants in Job Training Programs

Eligible New Jersey Job Training Program Participants (see Policy #5340 for eligibility criteria) will be entitled to waiver of payment of that portion of tuition from the program which is not covered by financial aid. The program participant will be required to pay all other applicable fees.

8. Volunteer Fire, First Aid and Rescue Squad Tuition Waiver

Eligible volunteer fire, first aid, and rescue squad volunteers, dependent children, and spouse (see Policy #5345 for eligibility criteria) will be permitted to enroll on a space available basis in any college credit course and receive up to \$600 in tuition credit per year, not to exceed \$2,400 for the member, children, and spouse collectively over a four-year period. Students enrolled under this waiver shall pay all college/student fees, course fees, late fees and other fees listed on the schedule of tuition and fees.

10. Eligible Ocean County High School Students

Eligible currently enrolled Ocean County high school students (see Policy #5122 for admission criteria and Policy #5327 for eligibility criteria) may enroll in college credit courses and receive a Board of Trustees scholarship award for the first six credits as shown on the attached schedule. Eligible high school students shall pay no college/student fees for the first six credits only. This benefit excludes all online courses.



Re: Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Operating Budget Request

Enclosed is Ocean County College's Operating Budget Request for fiscal year July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015. The overall budget is predicated on anticipated revenues in the amount of \$60,350,959. Compared to the operating budget for FY 2013-2014, the primary changes to our revenue sources are expected to be as follows:

Expense was reduced over the prior year due to the restructured Ellucian Information Technology refreshing technology and addressing deferred maintenance. Set aside funds have been allocated support contract. The savings were somewhat offset by increases to direct salaries including the additional of several College Lecturer IIs. The College is maintaining its commitment to both accordingly. Subject to the OCC Board of Trustee's approval this month, this budget will next be presented to the Ocean County Board of School Estimate later in the year.




