

## Using CINAHL Headings for Advanced Searching


**CINAHL Subject Headings** are *controlled vocabulary terms* designed to allow more effective searching of the CINAHL database. They are intended to describe content more accurately, assist in cross referencing, and allow the searcher greater control over detail and subject specificity. Searching CINAHL headings is similar to using a thesaurus.




Select "CINAHL Headings" from the database navigation bar

Search for a keyword like "diabetes"






**"Sub Headings"** allows the searcher to narrow a topic towards specific factors. For example, "risk factors" or "Drug Therapy."



Scope Notes
provide term
definitions and are
available for most
terms.

Subject terms can also be displayed in "**tree view**," showing the term's relationship to other subjects. Use this to find related topics.
