The following Finance Committee items are recommended to the Ocean County College Board of Trustees for approval at its meeting on **Thursday, December 10, 2020**:

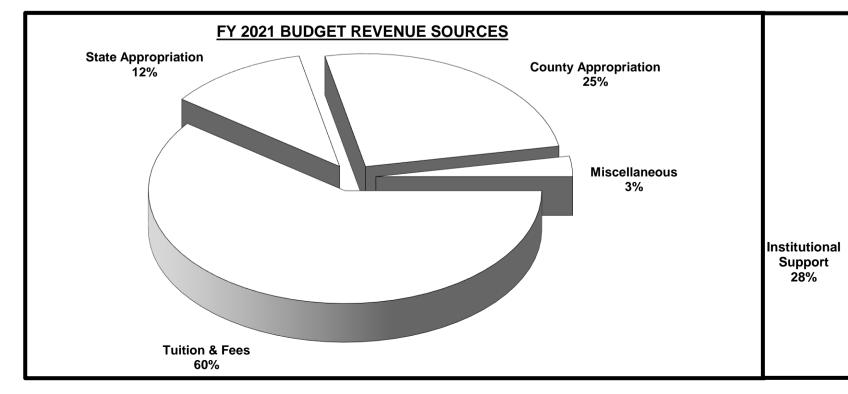

 - c. For professional digital media campaigns via Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, and YouTube for the College Relations Department at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-9)
 - d. For solid waste and recycling collection with the Township of Toms River at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-10)
 - e. For the renewal of web subscription of professional student retention analytics from January 24, 2021, through January 23, 2022, for the e-Learning Department at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-11)
 - f. For the purchase of benches for additional seating throughout campus to ensure social distancing options at Ocean County College through the Educational Services Commission of New Jersey (Exhibit A-12)
 - g. For the purchase of classroom projectors to provide interaction between instructors, inclass students, and remote students through the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) for use at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-13)
 - h. For a two-year agreement for street sweeping services from January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2022, at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-14)
- 6. Recommend that the following contracts be amended:
 - a. An additional \$3,166.31, for a maximum total of \$1,571,869.48, to Tri-Form Construction, Inc., Metuchen, New Jersey, to install a new three-phase breaker for the power monitoring meter and power for security devices for the HVAC system as part of the Conference Center Renovation project at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the January 23, 2020, Board meeting) (**Exhibit A-15**)

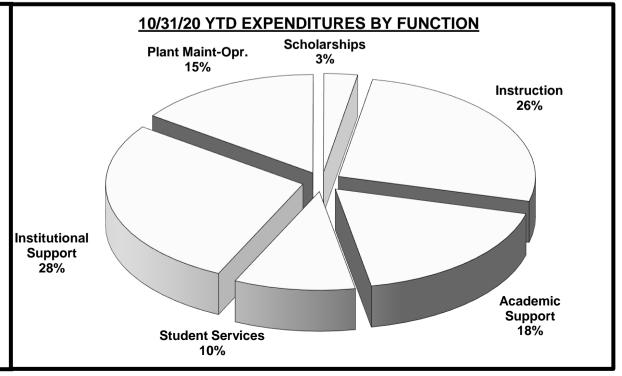

An additional \$7,687.88, for a maximum total of \$270,687.88, to Santorini Construction, Neptune, New Jersey, for carpet replacement, electrical and fire alarm changes, and a duct enclosure as part of the general contractor construction services for interior renovations for the student services area of Kean University at the Gateway Building at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the July 23, 2020, Board retreat) (Exhibit A-16)
- b. An additional \$48,375.45, for a maximum total of \$6,733,257.82, to Catel, Inc., Bradley Beach, New Jersey, for additional general contractor construction services to install new UV light filters, various electrical revisions, and changing plumbing fittings, as part of the construction of the new Student Enrollment Building at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the January 9, 2020, Board retreat) (**Exhibit A-17**)
- c. An additional \$111,001, for a maximum total of \$231,001, to SHI International Corporation, Somerset, New Jersey, for the purchase and installation of additional audio and video equipment for the Conference Center Renovation Project through the Omnia Partners Cooperative Purchasing Program and funded through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Higher Education Emergency Relief funds at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the November 5, 2020, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-18)
- d. An additional \$2,360, for a maximum total of \$95,480, to FM360, LLC, Charlotte, North Carolina, for additional consulting services to assist with the implementation of a new computerized maintenance management system for the Facilities Management Department at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the February 27, 2020, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-19)

OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE AND RWJBARNABAS HEALTH

- WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College has deemed it beneficial to partner with RWJBarnabas Health, a leading academic health system located in New Jersey, to offer credit college courses to its employees; and
- WHEREAS, consistent with an agreement between Ocean County College and RWJBarnabas Health, Ocean County College courses will be offered to RWJBarnabas Health employees for credit through the online modality; and
- WHEREAS, all courses will follow the curriculum and learning objectives established by Ocean County College and identified as prerequisites for GAINS-approved programs by RWJBarnabas Health; and
- WHEREAS, the Spring term will commence on January 25, 2021, and end on May 17, 2021; and
- **WHEREAS**, for the duration of the Spring term, the tuition and fee rates charged to students participating in the program will be consistent with the in-county Ocean County tuition rate (regardless of student residency); and
- **WHEREAS**, for the duration of the Spring term, Ocean County College will utilize available institutional CARES funding to fund the student lab kits needed for certain science courses; and
- **WHEREAS**, RWJBarnabas Health will be responsible for ensuring that applications, registrations, and tuition and fee payments are made to Ocean County College in accordance with established procedures; and
- **WHEREAS**, both parties agree to negotiate successor terms and conditions as the outcomes from the Spring term become known, and it is the intent of both parties to enter into a long-term, mutually beneficial partnership;
- **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** BY THE OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES as follows:

The President of Ocean County College is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with RWJBarnabas Health for the Spring term to offer certain Ocean County College courses in accordance with the above conditions for the period January 25, 2021, through May 17, 2021.

OC CARES Grant Agreement

This OC CARES Grant Program Agreement dated this 10th day of December, 2020, between the County of Ocean (County) located at Administration Building, 101 Hooper Avenue, Toms River, New Jersey 08753, and Ocean County College (College) located at College Drive, Toms River, New Jersey.

WHEREAS, the United States of America, the State of New Jersey, County and Ocean County College have become victims of the COVID-19 Virus and the Pandemic (the "Coronavirus"); and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus has caused economic damage and hardship to states, counties, and municipalities throughout the Unites States of America; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, the Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security Act (the "CARES Act") was signed by President Donald J. Trump; and

WHEREAS, the CARES Act was enacted, among other purposes, in order to combat the economic damage caused to states, counties, and municipalities because of the Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the County has received CARES Act funds from the United States Treasury (the "Stimulus Funds") to be used to reimburse the County, County Agencies, and Municipalities located within the County due to economic damage caused to them by the Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, as the recipient of the Stimulus Funds it will be the responsibility of the County to disburse the Stimulus Funds to eligible recipients in accordance with the terms and provisions of the CARES Act and any guidelines or regulations issued by the United States government or any of its agencies and/or departments; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the County to dedicate a portion of the funding to reimburse Ocean County College for COVID-19 related costs and expenses through the OC CARES Grant program;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is stipulated and agreed as follows:

1. **Purpose of Stimulus Funds.** Ocean County College understands and agrees that its eligibility for the receipt of any Stimulus Funds shall be determined by the terms of the

"Coronavirus Relief Fund – Guidance for State, Territorial, Local, and Tribal Governments" in the attachments listed below:

- Attachment A Coronavirus Relief Fund Guidance 4/22/2020
- Attachment B Coronavirus Relief Fund Guidance Updated 6/30/2020
- Attachment C Coronavirus Relief Fund/U.S. Treasury Reporting and Record Retention Requirements 7/2/2020
- Attachment D Coronavirus Relief Fund FAQ 7/8/2020
- Attachment E Coronavirus Relief Fund OC CARES Grant Ineligible Costs and Excluded Costs
- 2. **Role of County**. As the recipient of the Stimulus Funds, it shall be the responsibility of the County to act as an intermediary and establish a reasonable process for the College to submit an eligible reimbursement from the Stimulus Funds. The College agrees and understands that the decision as to the eligibility for reimbursement sought by the Ocean County College is within the sole discretion of the County.
- 3. **Use of Stimulus Funds.** The College understands that the Stimulus Funds represent an amount of funds which the County has received from the Federal Government for response and mitigation for COVID-19 related expenses. The Board of Chosen Freeholders has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the County that County Agencies be permitted to request reimbursement which meets the eligibility requirements established by the CARES Act and the Federal Guidelines.
- 4. **Processing of Claims.** The County shall accept and process claims for reimbursement. County Agencies are required to submit to FEMA initially for Category B Emergency Protective Measures Eligible Costs, such as personal protection equipment (PPE), sanitizing supplies, and overtime to name a few. The County will reimburse the County Agency for the 25% non-federal costs as approved by FEMA. Costs **NOT** approved by FEMA can be resubmitted to OC CARES Grant for consideration. All requests for expenditure reimbursement must be submitted to the County (using the forms and process as prescribed by the County) on a cost reimbursement basis.
- 5. **Non-Liability of the County.** The College understands that the County cannot guarantee that a claim for reimbursement is eligible for payment nor that any claims for reimbursements beyond the amount of the Stimulus Funds can be paid.
- 6. **Indemnification by County Agency.** The College acknowledges that the role of the County as to the distribution of the Stimulus Funds shall be as an intermediary. Consequently, if, as the result of any audit performed by the United States Treasury Office of Inspector General and/or any other auditing agency, department, or office of the United States Government, State of New Jersey, or County, it is determined that any reimbursement made to

the College by the County from the Stimulus Funds was not eligible for reimbursement, then the College shall repay any ineligible reimbursement within the time mandated by the United States Treasury or the agency, department, or office of the United States Government for the return of any Stimulus Funds. The College shall indemnify and hold harmless the County from any claim made by the United States Office of Inspector General and/or any agency, department, or office of the Government of the United States for the return of any payment received by the College from the Stimulus Funds. Included in the claim for reimbursement shall be any legal fees, court costs, or professional fees incurred by the County in defense of any claim made for return of any Stimulus Funds received by the College.

- 7. **Documents Required and Preservation of Records.** Any application for reimbursement must be sufficiently documented so that the County can determine the eligibility of the claim for reimbursement. A provision is included whereby the College certifies that it has not applied to the State or Federal governments or any insurer for the reimbursement of the same claim submitted to the County. The College agrees that it will not destroy or discard any documents or records maintained and/or relied upon by the College until December 31, 2025. The County shall have the right to make copies of any documents or records pertinent to the claim for Stimulus Funds and the College shall provide the County with reasonable access to the documents and records.
- 8. **Funding Reimbursement and Schedule.** As the County is obligated to expend funds on or before December 30, 2020, the County will provide reimbursement for eligible expenditures incurred by participating County Agencies for the period that begins March 1, 2020, and ends on November 20, 2020, using the following schedule. The County anticipates disbursement of funds in three phases. A fully executed agreement must be on file prior to funds being distributed.
 - Phase 1.

Expenditures: March 1, 2020 - May 31, 2020

Due: On or before September 1, 2020

Phase 2.

Expenditures: June 1, 2020 – August 31, 2020

Due: On or before October 1, 2020

Phase 3.

Expenditures: September 1, 2020 – November 20, 2020

Due: On or before December 1, 2020

Supplemental Report.

The County will permit the College to submit prior period expenditures not included in Phase 1 and 2 as a supplemental report, due November 1, 2020. Ineligible FEMA costs should be resubmitted with this report.

- Participating County Agencies shall ensure that all eligible expenditures are processed and paid no later than November 20, 2020.
- Final Report.
 Final report will be submitted for all expenditures. The final report must equal all submissions from Phase 1, 2, 3, and the supplemental report.

The County shall review the claims for reimbursement and may make adjustments to the reimbursement based upon a determination of eligible expenditures.

Ocean County College understands that availability of funds is contingent upon appropriations made by funding sources external to the County, such as Federal funds, and appropriations by the County Board of Chosen Freeholders. If, at any time, the County determines that federal, state, or local funds are insufficient to sustain existing or anticipated spending levels, the County may reduce, suspend, or terminate any cash, reimbursements, other payments, or allocations of funds provided by the County to the College, or other form of financial assistance as the County determines appropriate. If funding sources external to the County, such as Federal funds, or the County Board of Chosen Freeholders fails, at any time, to continue funding the County for the payments due under this Agreement, the Agreement will be terminated as of the date funding expires, without further obligation of the County.

Because there is only a finite amount of Federal funding, a pro rata allocation may be required. Ocean County College understands that the availability of funds is based on the total County-wide apportionment of funds resulting from cost-based reimbursement claims reported by each County Agency participating in this program as well as cost-based reimbursement claims incurred by the County. Depending on the total amount of cost-based reimbursement claims, the County may find it necessary to reapportion funds to each participating County Agency to ensure that the total cost-based reimbursement does not exceed the total amount of funds available under this program.

9. **Subsequent Funds.** Should the County be in receipt of any additional funds provided by the United States Government and/or the State of New Jersey to combat the Coronavirus for which the College may be eligible to receive payment, at the discretion of the County, the terms and provisions of this Agreement shall apply to the disposition and processing of those claims.

10. **Compliance with Federal Law and New Jersey Law.** The College acknowledges that the Stimulus Funds are subject to the oversight of the United States government and its agencies. Consequently, in incurring expenses for which reimbursements will be sought from the Stimulus Funds, the College shall adhere to the procedures established by the Federal government. Additionally, the College shall, when incurring any expenses for which reimbursement is sought, adhere to all New Jersey purchasing and procurement laws and regulations.

As a sub-recipient of federal funds, Ocean County College hereby specifically acknowledges its obligations relative to the expenditure reimbursement provided under this Agreement and pursuant to Federal cost principles, 2 CFR Part 200, "Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards," as applicable under other federal, state, and local laws, including, but not limited to:

- a. Fiscal and account procedures;
- b. Accounting records;
- c. Internal control cover cash, real and personal property, and other assets;
- d. Budgetary control to compare actual expenditures or outlays to budgeted amounts;
- e. Source documentation; and
- f. Cash management.
- 11. **Applicable Law and Attorney Fees.** Any action for the enforcement of any term or provision of this Agreement shall be governed by the law of the State of New Jersey and shall be filed in the Superior Court of the State of New Jersey, Ocean County Vicinage.
- 12. **Duration of Agreement.** This Agreement shall begin on the date first written and shall continue until either party terminates it upon thirty (30) days written notice, the depletion of the Stimulus Funds, or the end of the program period, whichever event occurs sooner.
- 13. **Approval.** By signing below the individual signing this Agreement represents that this Agreement has been approved and ratified by the governing body of the party signing it.
- 14. **Counterparts.** This Agreement may be fully executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and all of which taken together shall constitute one agreement binding upon all parties, notwithstanding that all parties have

not signed the same counterpart. Such executions may be transmitted to the parties electronically or by facsimile, and such electronic or facsimile execution shall have the same force and effect as an original signature.

15. **Notices.** Any notices that are provided pursuant to this Contract shall be in writing (including facsimile and electronic transmissions) and mailed or transmitted or delivered as follows:

- 16. **Severability.** If any part of this Agreement is declared unenforceable or invalid, the remainder of the Agreement will continue in full force and effect.
- 17. **Force Majeure.** No party shall be liable or responsible to the other party, nor be deemed to have defaulted under or breached the Agreement, for the delay in performance of this Agreement when and to the extent such failure or delay is caused by acts beyond the parties' control.
- 18. **Amendment.** This Agreement cannot be modified in any way except in writing signed by both parties to the Agreement.
- 19. **Assignment.** This Agreement will not be assignable by "County Agency" in whole or in part without the prior written consent of the "County."

CLARIFICATION to OC CARES Grant Agreement

The following shall serve as clarification to the language of the duly executed OC CARES Grant dated December 10, 2020, and shall supersede the guidance of the Grant Agreement:

All references throughout the Agreement to "municipality," "governmental agencies," and "fire districts" shall be construed as "local government entity."

- 4. Processing of Claims. The County shall accept and process claims for reimbursement. Any Category B Emergency Protective Measures Eligible Costs that have been submitted to FEMA (i.e. personal protection equipment, sanitizing supplies, COVID-19-related overtime, etc.) MUST be provided to the County with the supporting documentation given by FEMA to the local government entity upon submission. The supporting documentation provided to the County must include FEMA upload verification, expense type, expense amount, etc. The County will reimburse the local government entity for the 25% non-federal costs associated with the Category B expenses that are either under-review or have been approved by FEMA. Costs NOT approved by FEMA can be resubmitted to the County for consideration. All requests for expenditure reimbursement must be submitted to the County (using the forms and process as prescribed by the County) on a cost reimbursement basis.
 - A provision is included whereby the local government entity certifies that it has not applied to an insurer, the State, or the Federal Government (other than FEMA) for the reimbursement of the same claim submitted to the County.
 - Phase 1.

Expenditures: March 1, 2020 – May 31, 2020

Due: On or before October 1, 2020

Phase 2.

Expenditures: June 1, 2020 – August 31, 2020

Due: On or before October 15, 2020

o Supplemental Report.

The County will permit the local government entity to submit prior period expenditures not included in Phase 1 & 2 as a supplemental report. Due December 1, 2020. Ineligible FEMA costs should be resubmitted with this report.

By execution of this Clarification, the undersigned local government entity certifies on behalf of the entity that it fully understands this Clarification and will adhere to the updated verbiage outlined in the "Processing of Claims" section and that it fully understands the direction of the County as it relates to FEMA submissions. The Local Government Entity hereby certifies that it will communicate all FEMA submissions clearly to the County as stipulated in the Agreement. In addition, the Local Government Entity will not falsify or misrepresent any information submitted to the County under OC CARES Grant Agreement. Furthermore, the County will be held harmless for any wrongdoing or misrepresentation on the part of the local government entity.

On behalf of the Local Government Entity, Ocean County College, the undersigned has read and fully understands this Clarification, is fully authorized to execute the same on behalf of the Local Government Entity, and will adhere to all its contents.
