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

Proposals were evaluated by the Evaluation Committee to ascertain which proposal best meets the needs of Ocean County College. Proposals were evaluated using the following criteria:

- 1. Ability to monitor Ocean County media outlets and provide recommendations for local buys
- 2. Provide data / tracking for all media buys to drive future opportunities (no media retreads)
- 3. Ability to provide concentrated web capabilities (targeted)
- 4. Ability to deliver strategic media solutions to maximize ROI
