STUDENT AWARDS

\$750 is awarded to a graduating female student continuing her education at a four-year institution.

\$1,000 is awarded to an outstanding student demonstrating scholarship abilities and an interest in the area of English or the Humanities.

OCEAN COUNTY SHERIFF'S FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

Donated by the Ocean County Sheriff's Foundation, \$1,000 is awarded to a graduate of the Criminal Justice program pursuing a four-year degree in Criminal Justice who has demonstrated academic success and service to the community.

\$1,000 is awarded to a student for outstanding achievement in Engineering.

PRESIDENT'S LEADERSHIP TEAM SCHOLARSHIP

\$1,000 is awarded to two non-traditional students who have demonstrated commitment to successfully completing their academic requirements and persistence in managing demanding, outside responsibilities not experienced by traditional students, and who will continue their education at a four-year institution.

\$1,000 is awarded to a graduating student with a 3.0 GPA or better continuing in a four-year institution, majoring in Political Science and Government Studies.

OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AWARD
