An additional \$4,000, for a maximum total of \$24,800, to Safe-EMS & Safety Training LLC, Morganville, New Jersey, to provide additional in-person instruction for CPR/AED/Basic First Aid Courses funded by the Work Readiness Assistance Program (WRAP) Grant through the Workforce and Professional Education Program at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the November 4, 2021, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-26)
- d. An additional \$15,000, for a maximum total of \$46,536.51, to NCS Pearson, Inc., Bloomington, Minnesota, for additional side-by-side class books and activity workbooks for students enrolled in various programs and class books and activity workbooks for ESL students through the Adult Education, Civics, and Workforce Preparation Program at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the February 24, 2022, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-27)
- e. An additional \$2,572, for a maximum total of \$18,850.12, to SHI International Corporation, Somerset, New Jersey, for campus wide hardware and software for audio visual equipment through the NJEdge Microsoft Licensing Consortium contract for use at Ocean County College (initial contract was under threshold and did not require Board approval) (Exhibit A-28)
- 6. Recommend authorization to apply for a \$525,143 Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Grant from the New Jersey Department of Education for the purpose of developing more fully the academic, career, and technical skills of Ocean County College students through instruction, equipment and supplies, professional development for faculty and students, curriculum assessment and accreditation, with emphasis on those curricula that promote workforce and economic development.
