

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College recognizes the need to amend the contract for Apprenticeship experience for students studying Addiction Counseling at Ocean County College. The original contract in the amount of \$40,000.00 was awarded at the Board of Trustees Meeting on January 28, 2021. Amendments to extend the contract due to COVID-19 pandemic were awarded at the Board of Trustees meetings on April 22, 2021 and January 27, 2022 respectively; and

WHEREAS, an additional \$2,807.75 is needed for payment of an outstanding invoice to finalize close out of the GAINS Grant; and

WHEREAS, these services are funded through the Growing Apprenticeship in Non-Traditional Sectors (GAINS) Grant awarded by the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development (NJDOL), for the Addictions Counseling and Hospitality apprentices at Ocean County College. The purpose of the GAINS program is to promote the expansion and development of United States Department of Labor (USDOL) approved Registered Apprenticeship programs that drive economic development through skills and educational attainment and create pathways to better-paying careers and advanced credentials.; and
