The following Finance Committee items are recommended to the Ocean County College Board of Trustees for approval at its meeting on **Thursday, September 26, 2024**:

- 1. Recommend acceptance of the statement of income and expenditures as of August 24, 2024 (Exhibit A-1)
- 2. Recommend approval of the revised Ocean County College FY 2025 budget (Exhibit A-2)
- 3. Recommend adoption of a resolution authorizing the president to execute the operating agreement with the Ocean County Vocational Technical School and any and all other documents necessary to effectuate the partnership (Exhibit A-3)
- 4. Recommend that the following contracts be awarded:
  - a. For the first year of a two-year contract for legal services at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-4)
  - b. For professional ecological engineering services for phase 2 of the Nellie Bennett Marsh Restoration Planning project administered by the Barnegat Bay Partnership (BPP) at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-5)
  - c. For the first year with a second-year contract option for transportation services for OCC athletic teams for sporting events at various locations, various Student Life trips at Ocean County College, and various college activities, performances, and events (Exhibit A-6)

- 5. Recommend adoption of resolutions to award the following contracts:
  - a. For the purchase of access keys and vouchers for students enrolled in cybersecurity courses at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-7)
  - b. For travel services from September 26, 2024, through September 25, 2025, for the OCC Study Abroad Seminar in France (**Exhibit A-8**)
  - c. For the purchase of a Ford F-250 utility vehicle for use by the Facilities Department at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-9)
- 6. Recommend that the following contracts be amended:
  - a. An additional \$5,100, for a maximum total of \$30,100, to Success Advertising, Inc., Whippany, New Jersey, for a billboard rental to advertise OCC Manahawkin (contract originally awarded at the April 27, 2023, Board meeting) (**Exhibit A-10**)
  - b. An additional \$25,000, for a maximum total of \$40,000, to Jay Hill Repairs, Fairfield, New Jersey, for anticipated appliance repairs for the remainder of the fiscal year as part of the repair, maintenance, and installation of various kitchen appliances through the Hunterdon County Educational Services Commission (HCESC) Cooperative Contract at Ocean County College (initial contract was under threshold and did not require Board approval) (Exhibit A-11)
  - c. An additional \$15,000, for a maximum total of \$115,694.82, to Johnson Controls, Inc., Blackwood, New Jersey, for repairs to the Conference Center system as part of the chiller maintenance services at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the April 27, 2023, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-12)
  - d. An additional \$15,000, for a maximum total of \$45,000, to KT's Office Services, LLC, Lanoka Harbor, New Jersey, for battery replacements in the Data Center as part of the contract for power supplies and campus-wide printer maintenance services through the National Cooperative Purchasing Alliance (NCPA) at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the May 30, 2024, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-13)
  - c. An additional \$2,000, for a maximum total of \$97,490, to SSP Architects, Somerville, New Jersey, for updated drawings and specifications for bidding based on results from environmental testing performed in Building #11 as part of the Grunin Music Room Renovation Project at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the July 28, 2022, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-14)

- 7. Recommend rescission of the contract awarded at the June 27, 2024, Board meeting, to Harring Fire Protection, LLC, Folsom, New Jersey, for Fire Equipment Inspection Services as the College has determined that Harring Fire Protection, LLC, does not directly hold the required certifications to perform the contracted work. (Exhibit A-15)
- 8. Recommend adoption of a resolution to approve the scheduling of a sale of surplus Facilities/Warehouse items no longer needed by the College. (Exhibit A-16)
- 9. Recommend adoption of a resolution authorizing Ocean County College to enter into the Educational Cooperative Pricing System, a cooperative pricing agreement with the Educational Services Commission of Morris County serving as the lead agency. (Exhibit A-17)
- 10. Recommend acceptance of a \$202,570 grant award from the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education to transition the Center for Adult Transitions to an on-campus program to enhance programmatic support for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities to transition into the most independent living possible, aligned with their achievement level. Project Manager: Ms. Eileen Schilling, Executive Director, Workforce Initiatives. Project Period: July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025.
- 11. Recommend acceptance of a \$345,000 OCWDB Youth Employment Activities grant from the Ocean County Department of Human Services and the Ocean County Board of Commissioners for the purpose of allowing Ocean County College to continue providing free services to out-of-school young adults between the ages of 16 to 24, offering participants workforce skill development, career guidance, on-the-job shadowing, mentoring, and financial literacy. Project Manager: Ms. Gina Opauski, Director, Community and Workforce Development. Funding Period: October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025.
- 12. Recommend acceptance of an \$850,000 Barnegat Bay Partnership Implementation grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This cooperative agreement with USEPA Region 2 provides base funding for the implementation of BBP's 2012 Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan, which has four priorities: water quality, water supplies, living resources (habitats, fish and wildlife), and land use. The agreement provides funding for BBP staff to work with its Management Conference, that is, the BBP partners whose efforts contribute significantly to the protection and restoration of, and education regarding the Barnegat Bay. Project Director: Dr. Stan Hales, Director, Barnegat Bay Partnership. Funding Period: July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2028.


13. Recommend acceptance of a \$909,800 Barnegat Bay Partnership Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) FY23 Implementation grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. This Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) cooperative agreement provides significant funding to advance all BBP CCMP priorities. Thus, funds are committed to projects and activities regarding water quality, water supplies, habitat protection and restoration, and land use. In addition, 40% of all BIL funds are committed to advancing Justice40 requirements to benefit underserved communities (i.e. overburdened communities, as defined by New Jersey's Environmental Justice Law).



# Ocean County College FY 24/25 Budget Revision September 26, 2024

Re: Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Operating Budget Revision

Enclosed is Ocean County College's Operating Budget Revision Request for fiscal year July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025.

The FY2025 original budget was predicated on anticipated revenues in the amount of \$69,928,877. Now that the fall semester is underway, it has been determined that the enrollment projection in the original budget will not be attained. Secondly, while State aid to the community college sector was not reduced, the new funding formula resulted in a lower allocation to OCC than projected. The revised revenue projection is \$68,663,937. The primary changes to the revenue projection are as follows:

Enrollment Projected decrease of 5.2% compared to the original FY2025 Budget

Tuition \$1.9 million decrease Fees \$222,681 decrease

State of New Jersey \$448,414 decrease (Sector allocation level; OCC share of funding formula)

In order to help rebalance the FY2025 budget. expenses have been reduced in the following areas (figures are approximate):

Debt Service Set Aside -\$500,000

PBC -\$250,000 (reduced from \$500k)

Travel & Professional Development -\$240,000
Adjunct Salary & Benefits -\$200,000
OIT Consultants -\$100,000
Savings from Vacancies -\$200,000

In addition to expense reduction, fund balance will be allocated in the following amount to achieve a balanced budget for FY2025:

Fund Balance Allocation \$1,235,000

Pending Board of approval, the revised budget for FY2025 is balanced at \$68,663,937, a reduction of \$1,265,000 from the original budget.



# OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE RESOLUTION

### **Authorizing a Contract for Cybersecurity Courses**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College has identified a need to purchase student access keys and vouchers for students enrolled in cybersecurity courses at Ocean County College; and

**WHEREAS**, this purchase is funded by the Perkins Grant, a federal education program that focuses on increasing the learner's access to high-quality CTE programs of study with an emphasis on program improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College has a need to acquire goods and services which are exempt from bidding pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.3(a) et seq., any purchase, contract or agreement for the performance of any work or the furnishing or hiring of materials or supplies, the cost or price of which, together with any sums expended for the performance of any work or services in connection with the same project or the furnishing of similar materials or supplies during the same fiscal year, paid with or out of college funds, does not exceed the total sum of \$41,600.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Executive Vice President of Finance of Ocean County College has determined and certified in writing that the value of the acquisition will exceed \$17,500; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4, a Certificate has been provided by the Executive Vice President of Finance of Ocean County College, stating that funds are available for this purpose, which certificate is attached to the original of this resolution and is on file in the office of the Executive Vice President of Finance; and

**WHEREAS**, the vendor is required to complete and submit a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the County of Ocean the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

**WHEREAS**, upon receiving required vendor documentation Ocean County College wishes to give the President authority to sign a contract in compliance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 and without the need for public bidding in compliance with the provisions of County College Contracts Law, N.J.S.A.18A:64A-25.1 et seq.;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College, in the County of Ocean and the State of New Jersey as follows:

1. As directed by N.J.S.A. 18A-18A-11 et seq. and pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11 (5), the Board President is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Lead Agency.

#### **CONTRACTING UNIT**

The Lead Agency shall advertise for and receive bids from vendors who will make school supplies, equipment and other related goods and services available to participating members of the said Cooperative Pricing System at the agreed upon price; and

The Lead Agency entering into contracts on behalf of the <u>OCEAN COUNTY</u> <u>COLLEGE</u> shall be responsible for complying with the 54 provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.
