Planning and Budgeting Council Process

- Planning and Budgeting Council provides units with needed resources that fall outside of the normal budgets. All units are able to make New Money Requests for specific objectives which are vetted by area vice-presidents, presented to the PBC, and prioritized for funding.

- Utilization of VALUE Rubrics

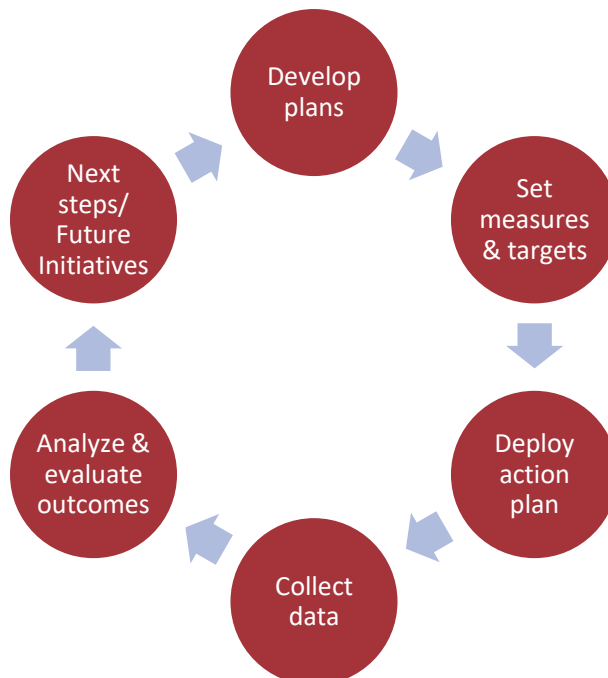
Comprehensive Local Needs Assessment
