*Thank you for your interest in the Early College program at OCC! Below are the steps to apply and register:*

### Step 1: Apply

Your first step is to submit a [FREE application](#).

- When asked “Why are you applying to OCC?” select: “I am a current high school student taking OCC classes.”

### Step 2: Register for Classes

- If you are registering for **Dual Enrollment classes** (taken at your high school for college credit), [follow this guide](#).
- If you are registering for **On-campus or Online classes at OCC**, [follow this guide](#).
- Click the link to the [Ocean County College Early College Program](#) webpage, scroll down to your school’s landing page, and follow the registration steps from there.

### Step 3: Complete the Parental Consent Form (Required)

After you register through Ocean Connect, a **parent/guardian must complete the [Parental Consent Form](#)**.

- The form can be filled out online and requires both the parent and student to log in to Ocean Connect.
- This form is required for all high school students to secure their OCC courses.

### Step 4: FERPA Form (Optional)

If you would like a parent/guardian to have access to your student records, you may complete the [Authorization to Release FERPA Protected Information Form](#).

- FERPA is a federal law that protects student educational records once a student is enrolled in college courses, regardless of age.

### Step 5: Tuition Payment

Payment or setting up a payment plan is due upon registration for courses. Follow the steps below to set up payment arrangements. Please make note of withdrawal and drop deadlines, and [review this link for our refund policy](#).

#### To make a payment

- Sign into [Ocean Connect](#)
- Click on the Plus (+) sign next to “Student Planning”
- Click “View and Pay Bill”
- Click on “Proceed to Payment”
- If this is your first time paying a tuition bill through OCC, follow the steps to create an account with NelNet.
- Set up payment arrangements
