Apply for Graduation (Students must adhere to graduation application deadlines.)	Students must apply for graduation from Ocean County College to activate their NJ STARS II funding. In order to be eligible for NJ STARS II, a student must earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 upon completion of an associate degree and transfer to a NJ 4-year school no later than the second semester following graduation from OCC. Participating in the NJ STARS program at a community college does not guarantee acceptance to a four-year institution. Students must meet all other entrance requirements as mandated by the institution in order to be accepted. Complete the Federal Financial Aid Paperwork	To apply for Federal Student Aid, go to FAFSA.gov . If transferring in the Spring, it is your responsibility to add your transfer school code on the FAFSA. Failure to do so may result in the loss of your eligibility. Complete the State Financial Aid Paperwork	To apply for NJ STARS II/TAG awards you must update your NJ FAMS account and submit any additional information requested. For local assistance, please contact the OCC Financial Aid Office at financialaid@ocean.edu or 732-255-0310.	Check with your new school for their deadline for HESAA State Application. Contact your new school to confirm that they have received your State Application. Please identify yourself as a NJ STARS student to your new school's Financial Aid Office.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Submit Paperwork if Selected for Verification	Students selected for verification: You must submit all of the requested documents/paperwork to your new school's Financial Aid Office and at nigrants.org by selecting Electronic Document Collections to upload your forms. Delays in supplying any requested documents could impact the processing of your Financial Aid application/scholarship eligibility. Please check with your new school for updated information.	Routinely communicate with your new school's Financial Aid Office regarding the status of your Financial Aid package.	<input type="checkbox"/>
