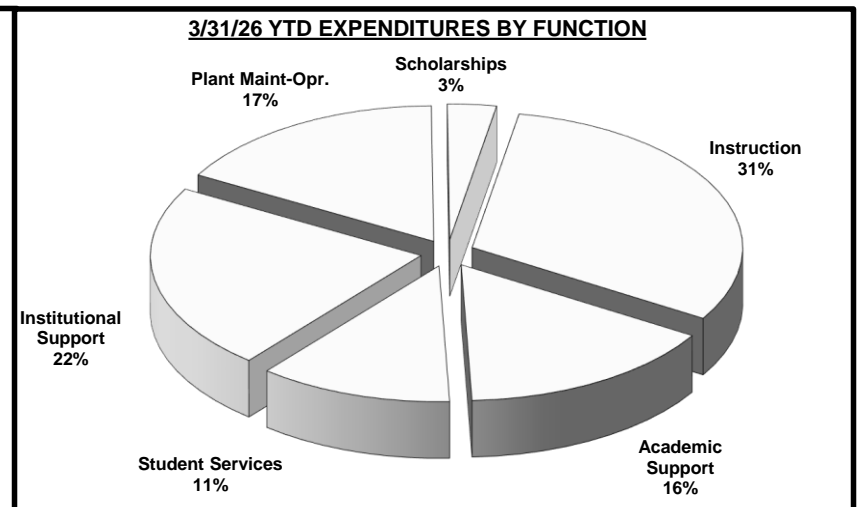
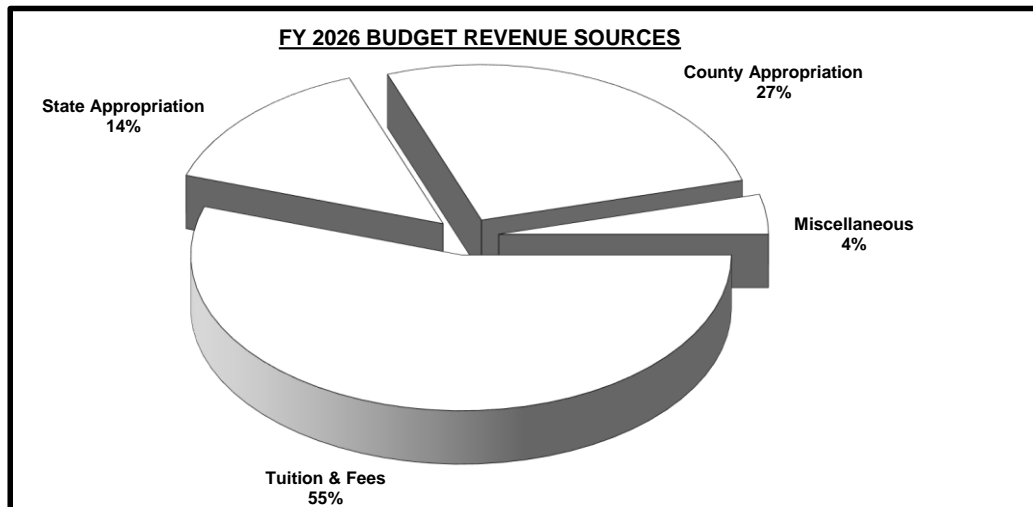

The second-year contract option awarded at the June 30, 2025, Board meeting, to Achieving the Dream, Inc., Silver Spring, Maryland, due to a reassessment of institutional priorities and a determination that continuation of the service is no longer aligned with the College's current operational and strategic needs (**Exhibit A-28**)
5. Recommend acceptance of a \$387,795 NJ Education, Climate Awareness, Training and Engagement (EduCATE) grant award from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, as part of a Regional Collaboration, the Barnegat Bay Partnership (BBP), and the Novins Planetarium (NP), both housed at Ocean County College (OCC), will develop, deliver, and disseminate full-dome planetarium and other guided educational programs on community resiliency and related environmental topics, in part with other RDI NJ partners. Multimedia/videographic contractors will assist OCC personnel in creating content for various audiences including K-12, college students, and the public via full-dome content, short videos, and live lectures. Programming will be featured at OCC NP, which presented engaging educational programs to over 38,000 attendees, including 12,000 K-12 students in 2023. OCC NP also collaborates and shares best practices with a consortium of NJ Planetariums (including Rowan University, Raritan Valley Community College) and reaches out through other public venues (i.e., Jersey City Public Library, Jersey Shore Girl Scout Council) to achieve programming outcomes. Programming will also be delivered via a portable dome to reach K-12 and adult audiences in coastal communities through various organizations (e.g., schools, churches, civic organizations, and public libraries). Educational material will also be disseminated via a NOAA Science on a Sphere Explorer Exhibit to make environmental programming more available to all audiences. Program Director: Ms. Nina Sassano, Associate Director of Outreach, Barnegat Bay Partnership. Program Period: May 2026 through September 2028.

**RESOLUTION**

- WHEREAS, the New Jersey Council of County Colleges has requested the community college sector submit a request to release Chapter 12, Public Law 1971, Capital Facilities Projects, not to exceed \$5,524,742 for FY 2027; and
- WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Treasurer’s Office is anticipated to release Chapter 12, P.L. 1971, funds to the sector; and
- WHEREAS, the State will commit these funds on a basis of fifty percent State and matching fifty percent County formula; and
- WHEREAS, the funds will be used to renovate the existing 30,775 square foot Administration Building (Bldg #1) which was built in 1974; and
- WHEREAS, the building will be modernized to meet current construction standards with a focus on safety, sustainability and long-term efficiency; and
- WHEREAS, the building will be repurposed to house new educational programs as well as existing programs that have the need for additional space; and
- WHEREAS, space within the building may also be allocated to offices and partnerships with external organizations that serve Ocean County and whose missions align with Ocean County College; and
- WHEREAS, the total cost of the projects is estimated at \$11,235,000 and
- WHEREAS, the project will be funded by FY2027 Chapter 12, FY2028 Chapter 12 and College funds; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College approved a ten-year Facilities Master Plan on March 26, 2016, which designated facilities improvement and construction projects;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ocean County College Board of Trustees approves the FY 2027 capital facilities projects, consistent with the recommendations in the Facilities Plan, and directs the appropriate College officials to request fifty percent funding from the State and fifty percent funding from the County of Ocean for the approved projects. The project is designated as follows:

FY2027 Chapter 12 Funds for the renovation of buildings on the main campus to update and renovate the Administration Building (Bldg #1) in support of new educational programs and partnerships.

Not to exceed \$5,524,742.
