- j. 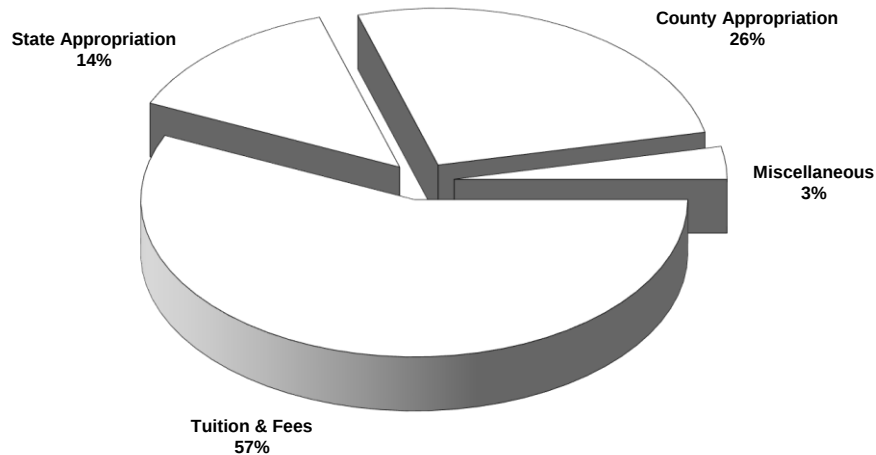

 - b. An additional \$11,500, for a maximum total of \$27,250, to AAMPED, Inc., McKinney, Texas, for the purchase of financial literacy educational services through the U.S. Department of Education TRIO Student Support Services grant, for students at Ocean County College (initial contract was under threshold and did not require Board approval) **(Exhibit A-15)**

Project period: October 1, 2026, through September 30, 2027. Project Director: Ms. Gina Opauski, Director of Ocean County Achievement Center.
7. Recommend acceptance of a \$71,768 Inspire! Grants for Small Museums, Office of Museum Services award from the Institute of Museum and Library Services, for the OCC Planetarium to install six space-related exhibits that enable people of all ages to engage in experiential learning activities that enhance knowledge and align with the planetarium's plans to become a science center hub for the region. Activities include purchasing and installing the exhibits, creating the Launch Lab space, and developing curriculum and interpretive displays for the new offerings. Project Period: September 1, 2026, through September 30, 2028. Project Director: Ms. Cara Muscio, Director of the Planetarium.

8/31/26 YTD EXPENDITURES BY FUNCTION

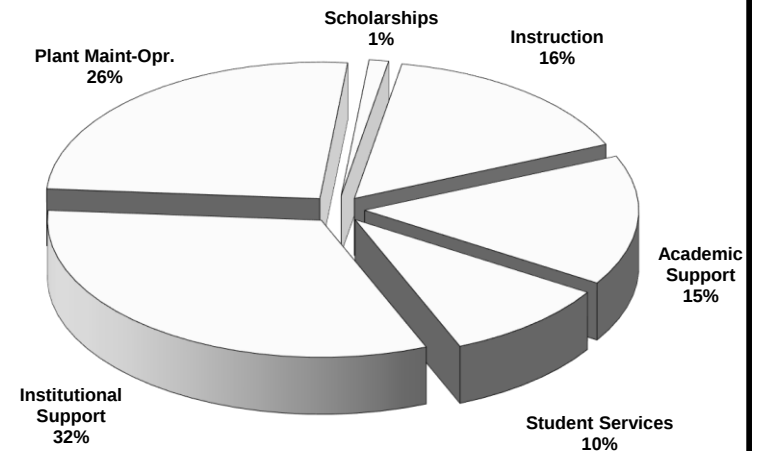
